- Singing is permitted but masks are required.
- Passing of the peace will be symbolic please remain in your seat.
- Remain in your pew until after the postlude. Once service has ended, please exit the building.
- Fellowship or coffee hour gatherings will not be held until further notice.
- Announcements and prayer requests should be emailed to the church office by noon on Friday or directly to Pastor Ho-Soon.

- Office area, kitchen, Bartlett Hall, Parlor of Peace, and upstairs rooms are limited to use by staff, worship team, and for pastoral needs only.
